



**Deleatidium:** Common dark mayfly found in most rivers. Can be found in fast flowing and slow moving parts of the river.

**Materials List:**

Hook: Black Magic A Series — Size 12 — 16

Thread: 6/0 Uni-thread Grey

Tail: Fawn Colour Hackle Feather

Body: Vinyl Rib

Thorax: Brown Antron

Legs: Black Flashabou

Wing Case: Black Thin Skin

**Method:**

**Step 1:** Bind hook from A to B leaving enough room for head. Tie in a pinch of fibres for tail and secure tie in vinyl rib at B.

**Step 2:** Return thread to A. Wrap vinyl rib in close touching turns to A and secure.

**Step 3:** Tie in thin skin for wing case at A and form dubbing loop. Put a pinch of antron inside loop and twist up tight. Wrap antron to form thorax and tie off leaving enough room for a nice tapered head.

**Step 4:** Fold one strand of flashabou in half. Tie in at head for legs. Hold legs back along body and secure with 2 or 3 wraps of thread.

**Step 5:** Pull wing case over thorax and secure. Form tapered head and whip finish. Add a touch of head cement.
